MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION Sylva Bay Academy Beta Club Junior/Senior Standards of Membership 2024-2025

The purpose of the National Beta Club is to promote academic achievement, character, leadership, and service at Sylva Bay Academy. Below you will find the membership standards in both the local Beta Club at Sylva Bay Academy and the National Beta Club and consequences if the standards are not upheld.

STANDARDS OF MEMBERSHIP

All students must perform at or above grade level to be eligible for membership. The academic requirements for membership in the National (Junior/Senior) Beta Club are:

- 1- To be invited into membership any student must have an end-of-course average of a 90 or higher in each course in which he/she is enrolled. Membership is based on the preceding year's end-of-course grades.
- 2-To remain active members after induction, all students must maintain an 85 average for each term of each course in which they are enrolled.
- 3-Any student falling below an 85 in any class will be placed on academic probation and will not be able to attend Beta Club activities until the grade is pulled up. Students have one grading period to improve their average. Any student who does not improve their grades to an 85 or higher will be removed from Beta Club and will be rendered inactive.
- 4-All members are expected to attend scheduled meetings. All Senior Beta Club meetings will be held in Mrs. Townsend's room at 7:45 a.m. on the first Tuesday and third Tuesday of each month beginning in September. All Junior/Senior Beta Club meetings will be held in Mrs. Bennett's/Mrs. Townsend's classrooms at 7:45 a.m. on the first Tuesday and third Tuesday of each month. Students who miss two consecutive meetings will be placed on probation and placed on the inactive list. Students must attend the next two consecutive meetings to be placed on active membership. Chronic absenteeism will result in removal from the club.
- 5-The service requirements for membership in the National Senior/Junior Beta club are 15 hours per year for Senior/Junior Beta Members. These hours must be submitted by April 1 of each school year.
- 6-The character and behavioral requirements for membership in the National Senior Beta Club are:
 - A. No student will remain an active member if he/she receives a formal discipline

- referral that results in disciplinary action by school administration.
- B. No student will remain an active member if his/her behavior in and out of school is in violation of the pillars of the National Beta Club which include achievement, character, leadership, and service.
